When is the club season? For club, we have three seasons (Tournament, Fall & Winter/Spring). Our Tournament season begins in May and ends in August. Most teams will do 3-4 tournaments during this time as well as scrimmages to get ready for our Fall Season. The Fall Season starts in September, consists of 8-12 games, and ends with a League Cup Tournament in November. Depending on the team they will either start their Winter Tournament Season or Spring league from December to April.

Important Note : According to CIF High School Regulations, high school players cannot play on their club soccer teams during the same time as the high school season.

When does registration open? Registration typically opens two weeks before the end of the previous season. Fall registration begins in May and spring season registration begins in December.

What will the fees be? We try to keep our fees affordable for any player interested in our club and can offer scholarships if necessary. Please speak with the coach of your age group for specific team fees.

What league will we be in? Currently all our teams are in the Coast Soccer League.
